The Douglas Tyler Burton Memorial Scholarship was established in memory of Douglas Tyler Burton, the 7 yr. old son of Ann and Marion Burton, who died in 1966. The Burton's were huge supporters of the Republican Party of Arkansas. The scholarship was established to assist needy students in obtaining a college education that would be a fitting and meaningful memorial to their son.

The scholarship is available to provide financial assistance and support to young women and men seeking undergraduate degrees or vocational/technical certifications. Awards are made on the basis of academic promise, good character, and financial need. An effort is made to grant scholarships to students who are not eligible for the large nationally known scholarships for which only a small fraction of high school graduates can qualify.

Applicants must be a member – or child of a member – of the AFRW or any affiliated Republican organization. Applicants can be high school seniors and first year college students, must be U.S. citizens and attend school in Arkansas.
